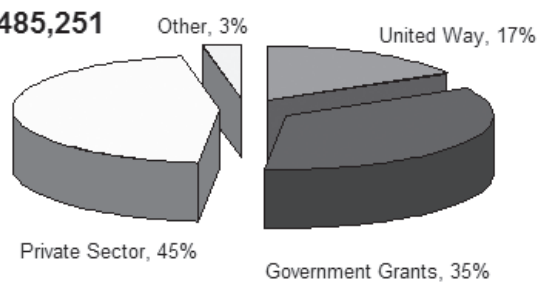

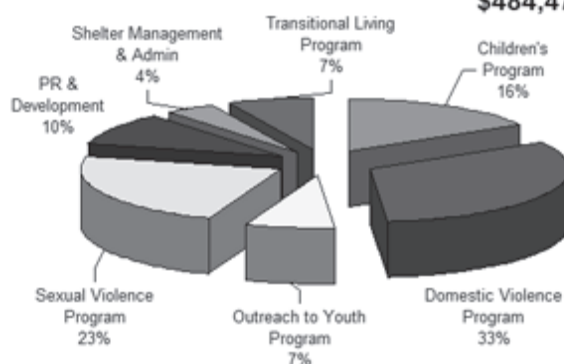
2006 Revenue
